APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION FROM COMPULSORY EDUCATION TO HOME-SCHOOL CHILD

We refer to your application for exemption from Compulsory Education to home-school your child, Sharifah Lulu Bte Syed Abdul Rahman Balkhi (BC No: T12162021).

2 We are pleased to inform you that your application is approved and that the exemption will take effect from 1 January 2019. The exemption is effective for as long as: (i) your child remains a "child of compulsory school age" as defined by the Compulsory Education Act; and (ii) the exemption has not been revoked.

3 Please note that the exemption is subject to the applicable terms and conditions set out in paragraph 3 of the Compulsory Education (Exemption) Order that is in force as at the Effective Date, and the additional terms and conditions set out below:

-  a) The parent conducting home-schooling must assume full teaching responsibility for home-schooling the child i.e. the child cannot be enrolled in full-time academic programmes in settings resembling a school. Please also note that the assumption of "full teaching responsibility" means that the functions and responsibilities of carrying out home-schooling cannot be entrusted or delegated by a parent to any other person or education provider.
- b) Parents are required to submit an Annual Progress Report pertaining to the child.

The exemption may be revoked if any of the abovementioned terms and conditions is breached.

4 Enclosed is a copy of the Annual Progress Report template for your use. The Annual Progress Report must be submitted by the 1st week of December every year until the child reaches the equivalent of Primary 6 in a mainstream primary school. The first Annual Progress Report is due on 6 December 2019.



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5 For curriculum and assessment updates and changes, you should access the Ministry of Education and Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board websites regularly. You should also inform the Compulsory Education Unit of the Ministry of Education if there is a change in your residential address and/or contact details.

6 Please inform the Compulsory Education Unit should your child subsequently reside overseas or cease to be home-schooled e.g. due to enrolment in a national primary school.

7 As your child has been registered as a pupil of Park View Primary School, please liaise directly with the school to complete the withdrawal procedure.
